The Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union Ltd., No. 1660 is registered as a Cooperative Society under the A.P. Cooperative Societies Act 7 of 1964. Its Address shall be the Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union (C/o Joint Director of Animal Husbandry/DPAP/Anantapur). Its area of operation shall extend initially to the entire district of Anantapur.

2. DEFINITION:

- 2.1 'Union' means the Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union.
- 2.2 'Society' means any registered Primary Sheep Growers' Cooperative Society Ltd., or any other Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Association or any wool marketing Cooperative Society which is affiliated to the Union.
- 2.3 'Board' Means the Board of Directors constituted as per the provision of these byelaws.
- 2.4 'Member' means the society as defined in the item (2.2) above and affiliated to the Union.
- 2.5 'Sheep Breeder' means a person who is engaged in rearing sheep and Goats, irrespective of caste and creed.
- 2.6 The Act means the A.P. Cooperative Societies Act.
- 2.7 'Rule' means the A.P. Cooperative societies Rules 1964.
- 2.8 'The Registrar' means the Registrar of Cooperative Societies A.P. Hyderabad or any other officer nominated by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- 2.9 'Managing Director' means a full time employee of the Animal Husbandry Department, whose services are loaned to the Union.
- 2.10. 'Department' means Animal Husbandry Department.
- 2.11 'Government' means the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- 2.12 'Commodities' means Sheep, Goat, Feed, Wool, manure, mutton, skins, Offals, other by-products of slaughter of Sheep & Goat, packing materials, equipment and machinery.

3.0 OBJECTIVES:

- The Chief Objective of the Union shall be to promote economic interest of it's members Sheep Breeders of the District, in the following manner.
- 3.1 Purchase and sale of sheep & Goat.
 - 3.2 Undertake the slaughter of sheep and goats by establishing slaughter House in the District and have sales of Mutton and the by products of slaughter.
 - 3.3 and Undertake to collect, process wool from the affiliated societies and if necessary organise to establish and Wool Processing Unit to further the interest of the affiliated societies and it's members.
 - 3.4 Purchase, pool sell and distribute the commodities from and to the offiliated societies and private sources after processing, manufacturing without affecting the interest of its members.



- 3.5 Own or have on lease or otherwise movable or immovable properties.
- 3.6 Purchase, processing, manufacture, distribute and sell Sheep feed and products of the sheep feed and necessary feed machinery, tools, instruments, packing material.
- 3.7 Encourage pasture and fodder development by the members.
- 3.8 Application of improved sheep husbandry practices to the breeding, health care to the flocks of the affiliated society members.
- 3.9 Undertake and encourage Sheep insurance work.
- 3.10 Own flocks of Sheep & Goat for producing stud stock.
- 3.11 Make arrangements for transport of commodities.
- 3.12 Organise new Sheep Cooperatives and develop the affiliated societies.
- 3.13 Impart training to the primary members of the societies about the sheep husbandry practices.
- 3.14 Render technical, financial, Material administrative, and other related assistance to the primary societies and members of the primaries.
- 3.15 Organise and encourage saving schemes to inculcate the habit of thrift.
- 3.16 Carry on cooperative propaganda.
- 3.17 Settle all matters of common interest of the affiliated societies and further their interest.
- 3.18 Establish a Research and Development wing by contributing its funds and raise funds from the members of the Union & others.
- 3.19 Arrange for providing drinking water facilities to the Sheep & Goats in the grazing fields.
- 3.20 Arrange for the bulk procurement of the medicines, tools, equipment required by the societies and supply them to the societies.
- 3.21 To enter in such other activities as shall be required to accomplish the above objectives.
- 3.22 To establish sheep breeders' Housing colonies with facilities for Social up-liftment of the community.

4. FUNDS:

- 4.1 Share capital:- Share capital may be raised by collection of Entrance Fees & Share deposit. The face value of the Share will be Rs. 250/-. The authorised share capital will be Rs. 1 lakhs. The entrance fees of Rs. 10/- shall be collected from each member at the time of admission. The members should pay the application fees of Rs. 100/- also at the time of admission.
- 4.2 Loans & Deposits: The Union shall raise loans and deposits from the members State Governments, Central Government, ~~non-members~~ and other financing agencies. The total borrowing of the Union whether from members or others shall not exceed 30 times of the paid up share capital plus reserve fund, however this will not apply to loans from Governments.

- 4.3 Grants in-aids & Subsidies:- The Union shall receive the grant-in-aids and subsidies from Governments and other institutional agencies & Foreign collaborations.
- 4.4. Investments: The Union can invest funds in the Nationalised Banks or in National Saving Certificates or in other Government securities.
5. MEMBER SHIP.
- 5.1 Membership of the Union is open to the registered Cooperative Societies defined as in byelaw No. 2.4. who take a minimum of 4 shares initially.
- 5.2 Each member shall pay the minimum deposit of Rs. 3000/-. The deposit is refundable bearing interest announced from time to time.
- 5.3 The members will be strengthened financially for the purchase of Sheep & Goat, which will be adjusted against the supplies made to the union by the members.
- 5.4 No society once affiliated can be disaffiliated without
- ⊗ 5.4 of the Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Societies Act.

- 5.5 The members if aggrieved shall however have the right for an appeal to the registrar.
- 5.5
1. If the member is a defaulted.
 2. If the member wilfully deceives the Union by false statement.
 3. If the member acts adversely to the interest of the union.
 4. ~~If the member fails to supply a minimum of 500 acceptable sheep & Goat per year to the union.~~
- 5.6 The liability of the member shall be limited to the share capital subscribed by him.
- 5.7 Application for shares shall be made in writing in the form prescribed and shall be disposed off by the Board of Directors.
- 5.8 A share certificate shall be issued every time as share is subscribed by a member.
- 5.9 A duplicate share certificate will be issued for share certificate lost by a member with the approval of the board of directors on payment of fee Rs. 10/- per share.
- 5.10
- ⊗ Section 27 of the Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Societies Act permits bans for after one year.
- 6.0 GENERAL BODY MEETING:
- 6.1 The Supreme authority shall vest with the General Body meeting. A General Body Meeting should be convened at least once in a year, within the quarter ending 30th June.
- 6.2 A special General Meeting may be called at any time by majority of the Board of Directors and shall be called within 30 days on a requisition in writing by 1/3 of the members of the Union or by the Registrar, or ~~Director of Animal Husbandry.~~



of the Union shall be president of all General Body Meetings. The General Body shall transact the following business.

1. To confirm the minutes of the previous meeting.
2. To consider the Annual report of the preceeding cooperative year together with a balance sheet of profit and loss account of the year.
3. To approve the distribution of net profits.
4. To elect the Board of Directors for the succeeding term.
5. To consider the amendment, by law's, if necessary.
6. To approve the budget for the succeeding year.
7. To approve the service regulation of the employees and allowances etc., to members of the Board.
8. To expel a member under byelaw-No.5.5.
9. To consider any other business duly brought forward for the general benefit of the Union.

6.4 VOTING:

1. Each representative of a member society present at the General Body Meeting shall be entitled to exercise not more than one vote.
2. The President of the General Body Meeting shall have a casting vote if necessary in addition to his ordinary vote.

6.4.3 The primary society can send only the President as its delegate to the General Body meeting.

6.5 In case of Annual General Body Meeting 15 days notice and in the case of special General Body Meeting 10 days notice shall be given by the publication of notice at the office of the Union or in atleast one local news paper.

6.6 The quorum for the General Body Meeting shall be $\frac{1}{3}$ rd of the total members or 25 members, whichever is less. ✓

6.7 With the permission of Chair any member may bring forward a proposal regarding any matter, not specified in the Agenda of the meeting, provided that he may not propose the expulsion of another member or an amendment in the byelaws.

7.0. BOARD OF DIRECTORS: The executive management of the Union shall vest in a Committee called 'Board of Directors'. The board shall consists of not more than 18 members as detailed below.

- 7.1. 1. 12 representatives elected by the General Body, out of which one shall be from S.C./S.T. community.
2. Three Government Nominees as under.
 1. Registrar of Cooperative Societies or his nominee.
 2. Director of Animal Husbandry, A.P. or his nominee.
 3. One nominee of the Apex Body of the State sheep Breeders' Federation.
3. One nominee of the Financing Agency.
4. One to be nominated by the ~~Animal Husbandry Department~~ from the experts in Sheep Development.
5. The Managing Director of the Union will be the member of the board.

7.2 Notwithstanding anything contained in these rules, the Government shall be vested with the power of nominating the first set of Board of Directors and Chairman.

7.3 THE TERM OF OFFICE: The elected Board of Directors shall hold office for three years from the date of assumption of charge.

7.4 Any casual vacancy on the board during it's term of office shall be filled up by cooption and such coopted member shall hold office for the remaining period.

7.5 As soon as the election of the members of the Board

7.6 Seven clear days notice should be given to convene the Board meeting. The notice of the meeting shall be sent by certificate of posting to the addresses of the members societies. The quorum for the Board meeting shall be seven.

* 7.7 Any delegate sitting in the committee of any other society shall cease to be such delegate if the society
a) which is delegate is defunct or commits default in the payment of any amount due in cash or kind to such other society for a period of three months .
b) The affairs of the society of which he is a delegate or wound up And if *

... the General Body of Directors shall have full authority to carry out the business of the Union and responsible to the General Body. The Board may meet as often as it may consider necessary, for transaction of the business but meet atleast once in a month. On urgent occasion, the business of the board of Directors will be conducted by a circulation.

8.0 THE BUSINESS OF THE BOARD SHALL BE:

8.1 To dispose off applications for membership and for allotment of shares.

8.2 To raise loans and to prescribe the conditions on which deposits may be accepted.

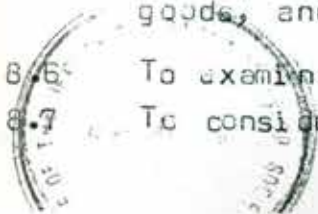
8.3 To appoint sub committee or committees for special duty.

8.4 To approve and certify the balance sheet and the profit and loss account for the coop. year ending 30th June and to prepare annual report, progress of work and agenda with the budget for the succeeding year to be placed before the General Body Meeting.

8.5 To arrange for adequate security against stealing, misappropriation, damage by employees handling cash, goods, and securities.

8.6 To examine stock register, and verify stocks.

8.7 To consider applications for loans and credits.



- 8.8 To sanction purchase of lands, buildings, to lease or sell implements, lands, buildings, machinery etc., for the use of the Union or for the purpose of letting the same to the members on hire and to acquire or lease premises for accommodating the Unions office and for storage of goods.
- 8.9 Appoint and removal of staff.
- 8.10 To carry on day to day administration of the Union to achieve the objective set out vide byelaw No.3.

9.0 MANAGING DIRECTOR:

- 9.1 The Managing Director shall be appointed by the Board of Directors. He shall be the officer of Animal Husbandry Department. He will be responsible for technical and managerial assistance to the union.
- 9.2 The Managing Director will be delegated the following powers.
1. He will be purchasing officer of Sheep & Goat from the members to the tune of Rs. 10,000/- at a time. For other purposes like maintenance of equipment machinery, purchase of stores emergency contingency articles and spare parts up to the limit of Rs. 5,000/- at a time. Any expenditure exceeding the above said limit requires the approval of the Board.
 2. Fixing the cost of sheep and goats, from time to time in consultation with the Sheep Husbandry officer of the District.
 3. All Employees or part time workers will be under his direct administrative control.
 4. He will be custodian of all documents, loan deeds, and properties of Union.
 5. To convene and attend all General Body and Board of Directors Meetings.
 6. To record the proceedings of the meetings in the minutes book.
 7. Arrange disbursement and to receive payment from other agencies on behalf of the Board of Directors.
 8. To guide, supervise and control the work of the staff of the Union and to perform particularly the following duties through them.
 - a) Maintenance of accounts and registers.
 - b) Preparing of vouchers and balance sheet and other documents, required for the business of the Union.
 - c) To see that the accounts of the Union are maintained up to date.
 - d) To conduct the day to day business of the Union subject to the directions of the Board.
 - f) To see that the audit certificate is placed before the Board of Directors for consideration without delay and to take further steps for rectification and submit the reports to the auditors in time.



DISTRIBUTION OF PROFITS:

The gross profit of the previous year shall be declared in the Annual General Body Meeting and the following deductions made from it:-

- 10.1 1. Interest payable on loans and deposits.
2. Working expenses of the Union.
3. Losses, if any.
- 10.2 The balance remaining after these deductions shall be treated as net profit. The net profit shall be distributed as follows.
- k 1. 25% of net profit shall be taken to the Reserve Fund.
2. To pay the share holders as dividend a sum not exceeding ~~10%~~ ^{10%} in proportion like share capital paid by them.
3. 3% of net profit subject to a maximum of Rs. 2500/- shall be credited to the Cooperative Education Fund to be administered by the A.P. Coop Union.
- 10.3 The balance after the above deductions, shall be distributed as under.
1. 65% as bonus to the members in proportion to the transactions done by them.
2. 15% shall be set apart to the credit purchases and the casualty fund.
3. 2.5% shall be taken to the Common Good Fund.
- 10.34 10% towards bad debts reserves to be in conformity with the amended rule of 36 (2) of the A.P.C.S. Rules.
- if the society does not meet the cost of the audit fees as prescribed under Rule 48 of the A.P.C.S. Rules or does not have its accounts audited at its own expenses.
6. 7.5% shall be taken to the building fund.
7. Any profit not allotted in the manner above said in any year shall be carried to the Reserve Fund.
- 10.4 If it is found necessary to make any change in the above pattern of the distribution of profits, it can be done only with the sanction of General Body meeting and the approval of the District Registrar.
- 10.5 The Board of Directors shall frame the rules for the utilisation of these funds.
- 10.6 In addition to the sums prescribed under section 67 of the State Cooperative Societies Act, all admission fees, fines, shares, share transfer fees, forfeited amount of share capital and donations shall be carried over to the Reserve Fund.
- 11.0 The livestock, other stock, machinery etc., which will be under direct control of the union have to be insured under General Insurance against natural calamities, theft, riots and other casualties.

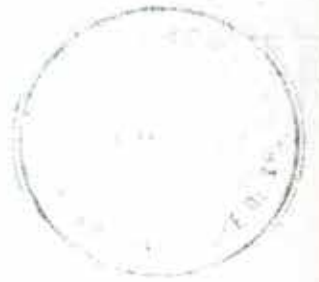

The model byelaws of the Anantapur Dist. Sheep Breeders Coop. Union are approved with the following modifications:-

Bylaw No. 4.1:- Under Banking Regulation Act, the societies are not permitted to borrow loans from non-members. Hence the words "Non-members" shall be omitted.

Bylaw No.4.2:- The Bylaw provides for borrowing loans/deposits from members/non-members and other financing agencies. The words "With the approval of the Registrar" shall be added at the end of the words other borrowing agencies. "Non-members" shall be deleted.

Bylaw No.5.4:- At the end of the words "Section 64" the words "of the Andhra Pradesh Cooperative Societies Act" may be added.

Bylaw No.5.5.:- The following words may be added at the end of the Bylaw. "The members if aggrieved shall however have the right for an appeal to the Registrar".

Bylaw No.5.5.4:- This shall be deleted.

Bylaw No.5.10:- This byelaw provides that the member cannot withdraw the share capital before 5 years. Section 27 of the A.P.C.S.Act permits bans for after one year which shall be substituted.

Bylaw No.6.4.3:- Any society can send only the President as its delegate to the General Body meeting. The bylaw shall suitably be amended".

Bylaw No.6.22:- The reference to the Director of Animal Husbandry may be deleted as he can exercise the same powers as Registrar.

Bylaw No.7.1:- For the same reason under item 4 it may be deleted.

Bylaw No.7.6:- There is no provision regarding the procedure for giving the notice. So the bylaw should be suitably changed as follows:

"Seven clear days notice should be given to convene to the Board meeting. The notice of the meeting shall be sent by Certificate of posting to the addresses of the members societies. The quorum for the Board meeting shall be seven".

Bylaw No.7.7:- It may be changed as follows:-

"Any delegate sitting in the committee of any other society shall cease to be such delegate if the society.

a) Which is delegate is defunct or commits default the payment of any amount due in cash or kind to such society for a period of three months.

b) The affairs of the society of which he is a member or woundup".

Bylaw No.10.2:- Deals with the distribution of net profits

10.2.2:- Payment of dividend shall be restricted to 10% to keep it in accordance with the rules.

10.2.3:- Allocation to the Education Fund shall be 3% profits subject to a maximum of Rs. 2500/-.

A provision for the creation of Bad debt reserve 10% of the net profits to be invested outside the business of the society may be made to be in conformity with the amended Rule 36 (2) of the A.P.C.S.Rules.

There is no suitable provision made to meet the cost of the loss of property by theft, riots or otherwise. A suitable provision may be made for the purpose. The provision is for dealing with the livestock which is subject to losses due to natural calamities. A suitable provision for the compulsory general insurance of the stock is necessary. The stock of livestock and others shall be covered by general insurance against theft, riots and casualties epidemics etc.,

Subject to the above modification in the bylaws after incorporations you may register the society by following the guideline already issued with regard to the registration of societies.

3. We appoint the following person to the committee to conduct the affairs of the society for a period of three months from the date of registration of the society or for such further period as the Registrar may consider necessary.

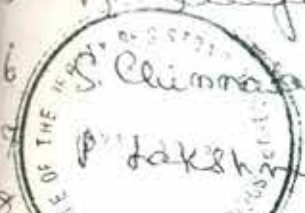

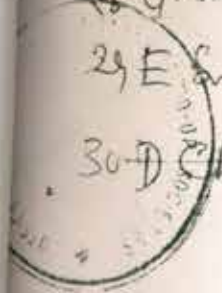

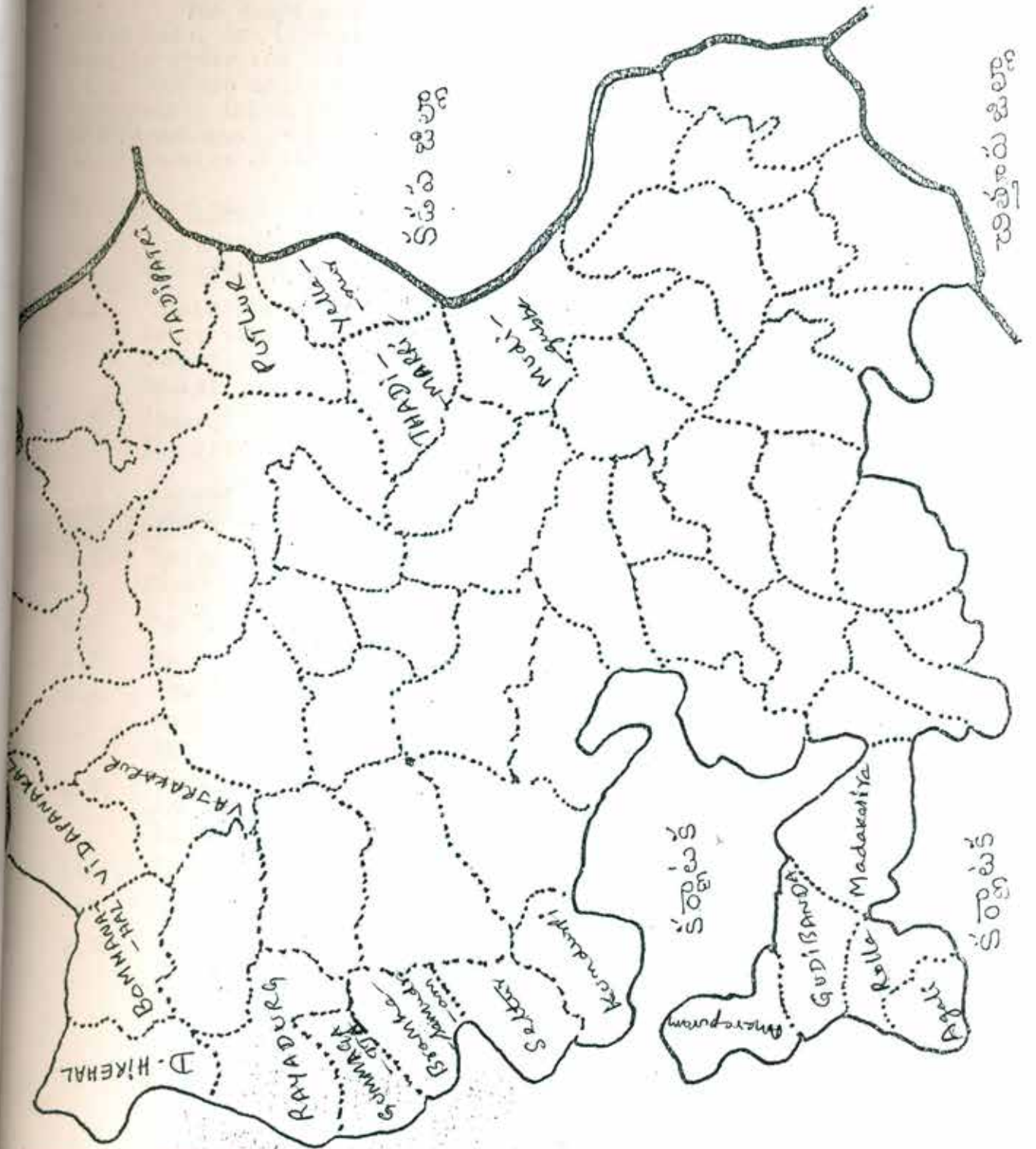

BYE-LAWS FOR THE ANANTAPUR DISTRICT SHEEP BREEDERS COOPERATIVE
UNION

---oOo---

The Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union Ltd., No. 0-1660 is registered as a Cooperative Society under the A.P. Cooperative Societies Act 7 of 1964. Its Address shall be the Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union (C/o Joint Director of Animal Husbandry/ DPAP/Anantapur). Its area of operation shall extend initially to the entire district of Anantapur.

2. DEFINITION:

- 2.1 'Union' means the Anantapur District Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Union.
- 2.2 'Society' means any registered Primary Sheep Growers' Cooperative Society Ltd., or any other Sheep Breeders' Cooperative Association or any wool marketing Cooperative Society which is affiliated to the Union.
- 2.3 'Board' Means the Board of Directors constituted as per the provision of these byelaws.
- 2.4 'Member' means the society as defined in the item (2.2) above and affiliated to the Union.
- 2.5 'Sheep Breeder' means a person who is engaged in rearing sheep and Goats, irrespective of caste and creed.
- 2.6 The Act means the A.P. Cooperative Societies Act.
- 2.7 'Rule' means the A.P. Cooperative societies Rules 1964.
- 2.8 'The Registrar' means the Registrar of Cooperative Societies A.P. Hyderabad or any other officer nominated by the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- 2.9 'Managing Director' means a full time employee of the Animal Husbandry Department, whose services are loaned to the Union.
- 2.10. 'Department' means Animal Husbandry Department.
- 2.11 'Government' means the Government of Andhra Pradesh.
- 2.12 'Commodities' means Sheep, Goat, Feed, Wool, manure, mutton, skins, Offals, other by-products of slaughter of Sheep & Goat, packing materials, equipment and machinery.

3.0 OBJECTIVES:

The Chief Objective of the Union shall be to promote economic interest of it's members. Sheep Breeders of the District, in the following manner.

- 3.1 Purchase and sale of sheep & Goat.
- 3.2 Undertake the slaughter of sheep and goats by establishing slaughter House in the District and have sales of Mutton and the by products of slaughter.
- 3.3 and Undertake to collect, process wool from the affiliated societies and if necessary organise to establish and Wool Processing Unit to further the interest of the affiliated societies and it's members.

- 3.5 Own or have on lease or otherwise movable or immovable properties.
- 3.6 Purchase, processing, manufacture, distribute and sell Sheep feed and products of the sheep feed and necessary feed machinery, tools, instruments, packing material.
- 3.7 Encourage pasture and fodder development by the members.
- 3.8 Application of improved sheep husbandry practices to the breeding, health care to the flocks of the affiliated society members.
- 3.9 Undertake and encourage Sheep insurance work.
- 3.10 Own flocks of Sheep & Goat for producing stud stock.
- 3.11 Make arrangements for transport of commodities.
- 3.12 Organise new Sheep Cooperatives and develop the affiliated societies.
- 3.13 Impart training to the primary members of the societies about the sheep husbandry practices.
- 3.14 Render technical, financial, Material administrative, and other related assistance to the primary societies and members of the primaries.
- 3.15 Organise and encourage saving schemes to inculcate the habit of thrift.
- 3.16 Carry on cooperative propoganda.
- 3.17 Settle all matters of common interest of the affiliated societies and further their interest.
- 3.18 Establish a Research and Development wing by contributing it's funds and raise funds from the members of the Union & others.
- 3.19 Arrange for providing drinking water facilities to the Sheep & Goats in the grazing fields.
- 3.20 Arrange for the bulk procurement of the medicines, tools, equipment required by the societies and supply them to the societies.
- 3.21 To enter in such other activities as shall be required to accomplish the above objectives.
- 3.22 To establish sheep breeders' Housing colonies with facilities for Social up-liftment of the community.

4. FUNDS:

- 4.1 Share capital:- Share capital may be raised by collection of Entrance Fees & Share deposit. The face value of the Share will be ₹250/-. The authorised share capital will be Rs. 1 lakhs. The entrance fees of Rs. 10/- shall be collected from each member at the time of admission. The members should pay the application fees of Rs. 100/- also at the time of admission.
- 4.2 Loans & Deposits: The Union shall raise loans and deposits from the members State Governments, Central Government, non-members and other financing agencies. The total borrowing of the Union whether from members or others shall not exceed 30 times of the paid up share capital plus reserve fund, however this will not apply to loans from Governments.

4.3 Grants in-aids & Subsidies:- The Union shall receive the grant-in-aids and subsidies from Governments and other institutional agencies & Foreign collaborations.

4.4. Investments: The Union can invest funds in the Nationalised Banks or in National Saving Certificates or in other Government securities.

5. MEMBER SHIP.

5.1 Membership of the Union is open to the registered Cooperative Societies defined as in byelaw No. 2.4. who take a minimum of 4 shares initially.

5.2 Each member shall pay the minimum deposit of Rs. 3000/-. The deposit is refundable bearing interest announced from time to time.

5.3 The members will be strengthened financially for the purchase of Sheep & Goat, which will be adjusted against the supplies made to the union by the members.

5.4 No society once affiliated can be disaffiliated without the sanction of the Registrar Unless it is dissolved and wound up under Section 64.

5.5 Subject to section 23 of A.P.Cooperative Societies Act 1964 any member may be expelled by a resolution by 2/3 of the members present at the General Body meeting and voting for any of the following reasons.

- 5.5 1. If the member is a defaulted.
2. If the member wilfully deceives the Union by false statement.
3. If the member acts adversely to the interest of the union.
4. If the member fails to supply a minimum of 500 acceptable sheep & Goat per year to the union.

5.6 The liability of the member shall be limited to the share capital subscribed by him.

5.7 Application for shares shall be made in writing in the form prescribed and shall be disposed off by the Board of Directors.

5.8 A share certificate shall be issued every time as share is subscribed by a member.

5.9 A duplicate share certificate will be issued for share certificate lost by a member with the approval of the board of directors on payment of fee Rs. 10/- per share.

5.10 No member can withdraw the shares unless he completes the period of 5 years, and/or until the liabilities are cleared.

6.0 GENERAL BODY MEETING:

6.1 The Supreme authority shall vest with the General Body meeting. A General Body Meeting should be convened atleast once in a year, within the quarter ending 30th June.

6.2 A special General Meeting may be called at any time by majority of the Board of Directors and shall be called within 30 days on a requisition in writing
